

DEATH THREAT FOR SQUEALERS

New York, Aug. 20—Death threats have been repeatedly sent to "Black Jake" Rose, "Bridie" Webber and Harry Vallon, who have made confessions showing alleged relations between the police and the gamblers, and all three prisoners are in a state of panic over fears that their lives may be taken. The three gamblers say they expect to be killed if they are taken through the streets to court. It is reported the prisoners have been intimidated by emissaries who have been smuggled into the west side jail.

The states attorney is anxious to capture Sam Schepps, who, according to the confession of Rose, paid over the money to the gun-men after the killing. Schepps received the money, Rose says, from Webber.
