> AMERICAN PACKAGES MUCH HEAVIER THAN CANADIAN

Dawson, Feb. 8. - Packages mailed in the United States under the new parcels post arrangethrough to Dawson. Canada transmits packages weighing no more than four pounds. The Second Ave. American packages will be carliried if weighing eleven pounds or under, the same as those originating in England. A good many parcels of eleven pounds or under have arrived here from Eng-

land for years past. The first American declaration form under the parcels post for goods for another country arrived here on a small parcel from Fairbanks, showing the establishment of the service there. The form is made on a shipping tag, attached to the package, and must bear the declaration of the owner of the nature of the contents and their exact value.

This, simplifies the work for the Customs Department. However, if the customs house should desire, it has the right to inspect the goods the same as under the express or freight system.
