VANCOUVER TEAM DECISIVELY DEFEATED After Leading Three to Two at End of First Period, Allstars Go to Pieces.

New Westminster, March 4.—After going along in good style for the first period and outscoring their opponents 3 to 2 at New Westminster the Vancouver hockey team, crippled by painful accidents to Si Griffin and Cyclone Taylor, went to pieces and Westminster tallied nine straight goals, eventually winning out by a score of 11 to 3.

Westminster shots came so quick and fast during the last two sessions that goaltender Allan Parr's head swam and the official recorder had writers' cramp keeping tab on the counters. It was the most lurid display of the season on the part of the Vancouver team and while it did not entirely kill that "chance for the championship," which has been bobbing up so persistently in every game the Millionaires have played of late, the defeat just about cinched the honors for Victoria. Now it is necessary in order that Vancouver should even tie the league leaders, Victoria must lose all its remaining games and Vancouver win every time out, not an impossibility by any means but certainly an improbability.

BANK ROBBER IS IDENTIFIED

Man Wanted in Connection with Bank of Montreal Robbery at New Westminster is Identified.

Atlanta, Ga., March 4.—J. M. Harris, or J. P. Montague, alias "Peoria Slim," held for attempted bank robbery, was today identified by Pinkertons as the man who they have sought for a year past, through two countries, for the \$272,000 robbery of the Bank of Montreal at New Westminster, B. C. He is the seventh of the band to be taken.

By his photograph he was also identified as one of the men who beat Lieutenant Bernard J. Burns of the Chicago police, into insensibility in a Chicago saloon in September, 1912, when Burns tried single-handed to catch three of the band of yeggmen.

Further crimes believed to be due to him, according to detectives who have trailed him for months, are bank robberies in Frankston, Texas, and Buffalo, Texas. Harris and three pals tried to rob the bank of Lumpkin, Dahlon, Ga., in the mountainous northern part of Georgia on February 14 last, but were frightened off and later captured. The other three are Charles Miller or C. J. Harper, alias "Nashville Jimmy"; William Flynn, 50 years old, record not known, and William Thornton, said to be wanted in Chicago for burglary. Harris and his band put up a stiff fight on Friday morning when lined up for their pictures. Revolvers were brought into play and the men were not subdued until reinforcements from the sheriff's office were rushed to the scene.

EXTRA SESSION OF CONGRESS APRIL 1

Date Announced by President Meets With General Approval

Washington, March 3.—The extra session of congress which President Wilson announced to-day would be called to meet April 1, will find a number of tariff bills ready for its immediate consideration and other general policies mapped out for the new administration. The date received general approval in Congress.

The letter from Democrat Leader Underwood, upon which Mr. Wilson based his decision to convene the session April 1, was sent after members of the ways and means committee had agreed that it would be possible to perfect several of the tariff bills by that time. Members of the committee predicted that those measures would consume less than a month in passing the house and that there would be no marked division of opinion in the committee over the preparation of any of the bills.

To Confirm Appointments The caucus of Democratic house members March 5 is expected to confirm to serve again all holdover Democrats now on the ways and means committee, and to fill the Democratic vacancies caused by the retirement of Senator-elect James and Representative Randall of Texas, and Representative Brantly of Georgia. The work thus far done by the committee will be reviewed by the new committee and the bills prepared in detail for submission to a full Democratic caucus immediately after the convening of Congress.

An income tax bill is preparing by Representative Hull, of Tennessee, and probably will be one of the early measures introduced in the House.

Money Reform Doubtful Whether currency reform will be taken up remains a question upon which members of both houses are in doubt, but it is believed that President-elect Wilson and the Democratic managers of the new congress will let it be known at the outset that they want the currency problem taken up as soon as it is possible to agree upon a system of currency reform.

Impetus was given to the senate reorganization fight today by the fixing of the open date for the session. The plan outlined contemplates the selection of Senator Kern of Indiana, as permanent chairman of the caucus.

Whilst away, Mr. Crippen visited a number of leading cities of Western Canada, including Vancouver, Victoria, Calgary and Edmonton. The trip which was made with a view to introducing to the trade the latest fish product put up in this city, Crippen's Boneless Herring was immensely successful from a business standpoint. There is every prospect that a large quantity of this appetizing local fish product will find its way to the markets of Western Canada this coming season.
