REGULATING THE HOURS OF LABOR.

at Monday week's meeting of the council in regard to having inserted in all city contracts a clause calling for an eight, hour day and fixing the rate, to be paid for such a day. The number of hours per day man shall work can safely be left to the individual to settle in most cases and in the others for his union to wrestle with the question. There may be instances, however, where the interference of constituted authority may work to the benefit of the laborer and here is a possible instance.

The United States Steel Corporation is about to be incorporated in Ontario and will set up an industrial city of its own near Sarnia. A United States that has been making an investigation of labor conditions recently reported that this corporation is working its hands at its immerse plant at Pittsburg twelve hours a day for seven days in the week. Twelve hours a day is too long for any man to work, especially at such hard labor as that of an iron foundry. Eight hours is deemed sufficient in any civilized state except that of Pennsylvania. and it must be assumed that the iron workers of that state are powerless to change their
