Their presence in the gay French capital at the same time was an unexpected coincidence, and mutual friends brought them together at a social function that was quite unique. The most pathetic figure of the three is that of Ex-Empress Eugenie, once the centre around which the world of fashion whirled. During the revolution in Paris which followed her country's defeat in the Franco-Prussian war she secretly escaped to England and has since resided at Chiselhurst, Kent. There she mourned the death of her son, assassinated in the Zulu war and of her husband, Napoleon III. Her first visit to Paris was in 1881, at the time when her nephew, Napoleon Victor, better known as "Plon-Plon," issued his famous proclamation. Through his friendship with the late Dr. Evans, who had carried out her escape from Paris, Mr. Coyney, now of the Daily News, interviewed the still regal lady on the pretender's aspirations for Reuter's and the Associated Press.


