Notice of Application for the Approval of Works, and for Approval of Undertakings by Statutory Authority

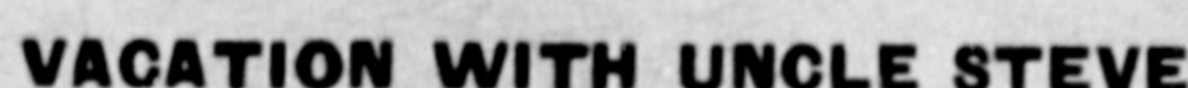

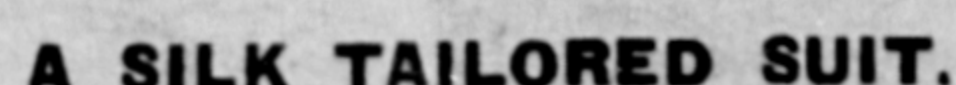
