Responsible government is perhaps one of the most outstanding phases in the present evolution of democracy. The principle was first established in the reign of William of Orange. It has proven a great boon to society, for it made it impossible that the leaders of the government should be out of sympathy with the people.

Responsible government however has developed another phase that will need some remedying before it will meet with universal approval. When a government gets into power! the first thing that it does is to select its Cabinet, and this body of men become the re-
