

## MUNICIPAL NOTICE

TAKE NOTICE that the Municipal Council of the City of Prince Rupert has fixed Tuesday, the Fifteenth day of January, A. D. 1914, at the Council Chamber in the City Hall, Fulton Street, as the day and place for taking the vote of the raters upon the following bylaws.

A bylaw of the City of Prince Rupert to provide for extensions and improvements to the Municipal Telephone System of the City of Prince Rupert and to create and secure a debt for the purpose of making such extensions and improvements amounting to the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00).

A bylaw of the City of Prince Rupert to authorize the purchase of an improved system for generating electrical energy in the City of Prince Rupert, capable of producing Five Hundred (500) kilowatts of electrical energy per hour less than \$100 per hour.

A bylaw of the City of Prince Rupert to provide for the extension of the Electric Light Pole Line System in the City of Prince Rupert and to authorize the creation of a debt to the amount of Forty-five Thousand Dollars (\$45,000.00) to pay for the same and the securing of the same with interest by the issue of debentures.

A bylaw of the City of Prince Rupert to authorize the construction of a City building on Fulton Street for municipal purposes, and for creating a debt of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) to pay for the same and to secure the said debt by the issue of debentures.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that the vote shall be taken by ballot, and that the polling booth shall be open from the said fifteenth day of January, A. D. 1914, from the hour of 9:00 a. m. until the hour of 7:00 p. m.

AND FURTHER TAKE NOTICE that F. R. Brown has been appointed Returning Officer to take charge of the said vote.

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT TO PROVIDE FOR EXTENSIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS TO THE MUNICIPAL TELEPHONE SYSTEM OF THE CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT AND TO CREATE AND SECURE A DEBT FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING SUCH EXTENSIONS AND IMPROVEMENTS AMOUNTING TO THE SUM OF SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$60,000.00):

WHEREAS the city of Prince Rupert at present possesses its own telephone system and such system is now insufficient to serve the requirements of the citizens of Prince Rupert and it has become necessary to improve and extend the said system;

AND WHEREAS a petition has been duly signed by the required number of property holders of the said city requesting the Municipal Council of the City of Prince Rupert to introduce this bylaw and said petition has been introduced pursuant to this petition;

AND WHEREAS for the purpose of making such improvements and extensions it will be necessary to incur a debt in the amount of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00);

AND WHEREAS the City intends to issue debentures for the amount of the said debt, being Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00), by the sale of which to realize the monies necessary for the said purpose, said debentures to extend over a period of twenty (20) years from the second (2nd) day of January, A. D. 1914, and to be repaid out of the sum of money realized upon the sale of the said debentures.

The Council may sell said debentures at less than par if it is found necessary or advisable to do so;

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT TO AUTHORIZE THE PURCHASE AND INSTALLATION OF AN IMPROVED SYSTEM FOR GENERATING ELECTRICAL ENERGY IN THE CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT, CAPABLE OF PRODUCING FIVE HUNDRED (500) KILOWATTS OF ELECTRICAL ENERGY, AND TO CREATE A DEBT TO THE EXTENT OF ONE HUNDRED AND FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$150,000.00):

AND WHEREAS the sum necessary for the payment of interest during the currency of the said debentures to be issued hereunder is the sum of One Hundred and Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) to exceed twenty per cent. (20%) of the value of the assessed lands and improvements according to the last revised assessment roll;

AND WHEREAS the total amount which will have to be raised annually for the purpose of paying the said debt and interest will be Five Thousand One Hundred and Two Thousand Dollars and Sixty-six Cents (\$5,121.66);

AND WHEREAS the sum necessary for the payment of interest during the currency of the said debentures to be issued hereunder is the sum of Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00);

AND WHEREAS the sum to be set aside annually by way of sinking fund to discharge the debt authorized to be created by this bylaw is the sum of Two Thousand One Hundred and Twenty-one Dollars and Sixty-six Cents (\$2,121.66); and it is proposed to set aside such annual sum of Two Thousand One Hundred and Twenty-one Dollars and Sixty-six Cents (\$2,121.66) by depositing the same quarterly at interest in a chartered bank or trust company in Canada, or by investing the same in any manner that a municipal corporation may legally adopt;

AND WHEREAS the quantity of electric energy supplied by the said system is fast becoming too small for the requirements of the city and private consumers; and WHEREAS the present system of producing electrical energy by steam is not economical;

AND WHEREAS improved and more economical methods of producing electricity have already been introduced into other places and it is the desire of the City Council of the City of Prince Rupert to take advantage of such improvements; and WHEREAS it is desirable to install an improved system for the production of electrical energy in the City of Prince Rupert, such system to be used hereunder to the intent of this bylaw being that the City in making the improvements to the City's telephone system shall do everything to make the same complete in every particular;

AND WHEREAS this bylaw cannot be altered save with the consent of the Lieutenant Governor in Council;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

This bylaw shall take effect on the thirty-first (31st) day of January, A. D. 1914;

it shall be lawful for the City of Prince Rupert to extend and improve the present municipal telephone system in accordance to plans and specifications to be prepared by the Manager for the time being of the municipal telephone system, and to be approved by the Council, and to add to during the construction of such extensions and improvements, all such alterations, amendments and additions to be approved by the said manager, and to be made in the said manner, as the original plans and specifications. All such plans and specifications together with any alterations, amendments or additions thereto shall be filed with the names of the telephone companies in the intent of this bylaw being that the City in making the improvements to the City's telephone system shall do everything to make the same complete in every particular;

For the purpose of paying for the said extensions hereby authorized the City of Prince Rupert is hereby empowered to issue debt of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) which debt shall be payable in twenty (20) years from the second (2nd) day of January, A. D. 1914, and for which debt debentures shall be issued to be secured in manner hereinafter agreed;

The sum of Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) is necessary for the payment of interest each year during the currency of the said debentures, and the sum of Two Thousand One Hundred and Twenty-one Dollars and Sixty-six Cents (\$2,121.66) is necessary to be set aside annually during the currency of the said debentures for the purpose of forming a sinking fund to discharge the debt at maturity. The said sum of Two Thousand One Hundred and Twenty-one Dollars and Sixty-six Cents (\$2,121.66) shall be annually raised as follows, namely by a rate levied annually on the assessed value of lands and improvements according to the last revised assessment roll;

7. There shall be issued any number of debentures to be made in such sums as may be required for raising the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) and said debentures may be expressed either in currency or sterling money payable in two years from the date of issue or in two years from the date of issue, to be duly prepared, executed and sealed;

8. The said debentures shall be deemed to have been properly executed by being signed by the Mayor and the Treasurer of the said City and shall be sealed with its corporate seal;

9. The said debentures shall bear date the Second (2nd) day of January, A. D. 1914, and shall contain a promise to pay the principal of the said debentures and also the interest thereon at the rate of three and one-half per cent. (3 1/2%) per annum, payable on the First (1st) day of January and the First (1st) day of January of each year thereafter, to be paid with or without coupons attached thereto, and the coupons of interest and in case coupons shall be attached to said debentures each of said coupons shall be equivalent to one half year's interest at the rate of five per cent. (5%) per annum, payable on the First (1st) day of January and the First (1st) day of January of each year thereafter, to be paid with or without coupons attached thereto, and the coupons of interest and in case coupons shall be attached to said debentures each of said coupons shall be equivalent to one half year's interest at the rate of five per cent. 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
