

MODEL CHARTER IS PLANNED FOR SEATTLE

Committee of Business Men Got Together and Drew up a Scheme

Fifteen well selected freeholders, men of integrity, capacity and well developed civic consciences, have finished a serious work in the study, development and draft of a new progressive charter for the city of Seattle and upon which the electorate will express its pleasure June 30, 1914.

While city government is a business peculiar unto itself and its efficiency, or lack of efficiency, cannot be properly measured by the standards of private corporations, yet there are certain fundamental principles which students of municipal government believe can be applied to either, or both. Organization and discipline are vital in the conduct of private and public business.

It is doubtful if a charter can be framed by any group of people which will be wholly satisfactory to them, to say nothing of being acceptable all the time to all the people, but the present proposed charter for Seattle is unique, a copy of none, a composite of many, a culmination of experience in public service and an endeavor to anticipate the popular demand and the present tendency in municipal government. The exponents of the "commission form" of city government are leaders of the opposition to it. The principal features of the charter are set out below:

The city legislative power will be vested in a mayor any city council.

Administrative and executive powers will be vested in a city manager and his subordinates. The city manager supercedes the board of public works, which goes out of existence.

Elective officials will be the mayor and councilmen, selected by a preferential system of voting.

The council will be composed of one member elected from each of thirty councilmanic districts of the city. Councilmen serve two years with compensation at \$5 a meeting, to be paid for not to exceed sixty meetings per annum.

Mayor will be elected at large to serve two years, with a salary of \$5,000 per annum. He will be the official head of the city for legal and ceremonial purposes, and the head of the police department, appointing the chief of police. He will preside at the council meetings, with any a vote in case of tie under certain conditions.

City manager will serve four years at \$12,000 per annum. He will be subject to removal by vote of the council and the people by a form of recall.

Campaign expenses of councilmanic candidates are limited to \$100 and of mayoralty candi-

dates to \$500, the limitations to exclude filing fees and cost of printing and mailing circulars to voters.

Councilmanic appointees are the city manager, clerk, corporation counsel, treasurer and comptroller, each to serve four-year terms. These officers are elected by the council by preferential vote if there are three or more candidates.

Welfare commission of three unsalaried officials, appointed by the mayor for three-year terms, is to manage all charitable, correctional and reformatory institutions and agencies, lodging houses and similar institutions, regulate the public amusements and make research in regard to social problems.
