The Kaiser has had a good many bad names hurled at him since the beginning of the war but a recent issue of The Scotsman produces evidence that relegates him to the Order of Annanais. This is what it has to say about him:

"The Kaiser's handling of international politics has been a record of continuous failure, and failure which has been stained on more than one occasion by duplicity. To give but one example of the moral obliquity of his diplomacy, it may be recalled that in 1908 he caused to be published in the Daily Telegraph an account of an interview in which he stated that he was Great Britain's chief friend in Europe, and that he alone had prevented the European powers from bringing pressure to bear upon us to stop the South African war. 'When the struggle was at its height,' he said, the governments of France and Russia invited me to join with them to call upon England to put an end to the war. The moment had come to humiliate England to the dust. Posterity will one day read the exact terms of the telegram-now in the archives of Windsor Castle -in which I informed the Sovereign of England of the answer I had returned to the powers, which then sought to com-

> Immediately, Dr. David Starr Jordan, known the world over as a non-partisan internationalist. and who had already spoken, craved the liberty of endorsing the German Privy Councillor's estimate of Prof. Oppenheim, "perhaps the very greatest authority on international law," and Dr. Jordan's personal friend. "I visited him in England at the very time when these issues were trembling in the balance. Germany had not yet invaded Belgian territory. We both agreed that Britain ought not to interfere. But Dr. Oppenheim by birth and by education and by citizenship is a German. He was professor in Freiburg and in Basle before going to Cambridge. He is still a German citizen. At this moment I have in my pocket a letter from him written since the war began." Dr. Jordan read the letter as follows:

"Dear Dr. Jordan, - When we met last we did not know that Germany was perpetrating the greatest international crime which has been committed since the time of Napoleon I, namely, the violation of the permanent neutrality of Belgium. .
