Wheel Traffic Diverted Between First and McBride Streets via Second Avenue.

At last the heavy gap between First Street and McBride Street is being filled solidly. In a few days it is probable that traffic will be relieved of the steep grade which has been made temporarily on Third Avenue at this point, just past the News office towards McBride Street. Meanwhile, in order that the fill may be speedily completed, traffic has been diverted through First Street on to Second Avenue, and so on to McBride Street, Third Avenue being closed entirely until by day and night labor the desired level grade can be achieved. Fill is being brought by the longest haul yet necessary in Prince Rupert street grading all the way from Fifth Street via Second Avenue.

Alpine climbing is the latest stunt for section six citizens on their way citywards.
