Sensational Discovery Made by English Inventor-Instrument Value \$48 Will Work Miracle of Telephony.

An English inventor, Grindell Matthews, with the aid of a \$48 instrument known as the aerophone, has just succeeded in projecting the sound of his voice through material which the biggest steel projectile on earth would fail to penetrate. United States Consul General John L. Griffiths of London in a consular report says that Mr. Matthews was placed in the strong room of a big London commercial house and locked in with nine inches of armor steel, nine inches of fire brick and six feet of concrete between him and the outer world. By means of his small portable apparatus he carried on a conversation with an operator in another room on the farther side of the building.
