



The depths of planting given in the table may be considered minimums; deeper planting may often be advisable. One of the chief hazards for all bulbs is "frost heaving." due to alternate freezing and thawing of the soil, which may lift shallow rooted plants out of the soil. Bulbs planted so late they cannot make roots in the fall are likely to suffer from it; and large bulbs not set deep enough will often be injured. A mulch placed over the bulbs after the ground has frozen will keep the frost in, and re-

iuce frost heaving. When it is intended to allow tulips to remain where you plant them several years rather than dig them up after they! have blossomed and their leaves? have turned yellow each summer, they should be planted two or three inches deeper than the normal depth.


